B. New Business

1. Review and Certification of Second Interim Report

Education Code (EC) Sections 35035(g), 42130, and 42131 require the governing board of each school district to certify twice a year the district's ability to meet its financial obligations for the remainder of the current and two subsequent fiscal years. This is referred to as the Interim Report Process.

The First Interim Report for 2023-24 for the period of July 1, 2023 through October 31, 2023 was due to the Tulare County Office of Education by December 15, 2023. The second interim report is due March 15 for the period ending January 31, 2024.

2. Approval of contract between M. Green and Company LLP and Stone Corral School District

Each year, districts audit their financial statements. Earlier this year, the Governing Board approved M. Green and Company LLP as the company to do this annual audit. This is the contract for the audit agreement.

3. District Instructional Calendar

The district calendar for 2024-2025 will be introduced to the Board for review. The final draft will be presented approval at the board meeting in April, 2024.

4. Acceptance of Crescent Valley Public Charter School II Second Interim Report

Crescent Valley Public Charter School II is chartered by Stone Corral School. Crescent Valley has submitted their Second Interim Report to the district and is presented to the Stone Corral Board of Education for review.

5. Setting June Public Hearing Date for the 2024-2025 Budget

Pursuant to Education Code 42103, each school district governing board shall hold a public hearing on the proposed budget during which time any member of the public may appear and be heard regarding the proposed budget. The public hearing shall be held not less than three working days following the availability of the proposed budget for public inspection. Our usual board meeting date is scheduled for Thursday, June 13, 2024 at 5:30 p.m. for the public hearing.

6. Unresolved Audit Findings

The district went through their annual audit for the fiscal year 2021-2022. There were two findings in the report. The findings, background, and corrective action are presented.

7. Transportation Services Plan

As a condition of receiving apportionments under Section 41850.1, a district shall develop a plan describing the transportation services it will offer to its pupils, and how it will prioritize planned transportation services for pupils in transitional kindergarten, kindergarten, and any of grades 1 to 6, inclusive, and pupils who are low income
